

Regional Network Lead – Headline FAQs

Start date: As soon as practical but we appreciate we may need to wait for notice periods. We will wait to appoint for the right candidate

Career to date: Experience within the commercial sector with an appreciation of the education and STEM sectors. Experience of cultivating income streams, working with external partners, developing new leads and progressing partnerships. Strong networking skills.

Pension: Universities Superannuation Scheme: 8% Employee contribution; 18% Employer contribution. Career average scheme. Pensions can be transferred in and out of the scheme.

Salary: Appointments are made on 'spot' salaries within a broad band £45k - £55k and are awarded subject to previous experience. We do not operate teacher or public sector pay and condition pay scales.

Holidays: 30 days, plus bank holidays. These can be taken at any time of year and up to a maximum of 3 weeks off at any one time.

Flexible working: The notional hours for the role are 37 hours per week with the expectation your hours will flex to the needs of the role but you will be able to take back time for attending events during the evening or on a weekend. There are no fixed start and finish times each day.

Travel: This role has an expectation of one day per week (on average) of working from your home office. The remainder of the week will involve meetings across your designated region or attending meetings in York or London. Where possible we anticipate you will use public transport but some regions may involve 'remote' meetings which may necessitate driving.

National meetings: Travel to York or London will take place at least fortnightly, sometimes more frequently. You will be expected to be able to stay overnight for some meetings to make best use of your time. Most national meetings are booked well in advance to enable planning.

Matrix management: We operate in a commercial environment using matrix management across the business to ensure we are swift in our responses and effective in our delivery of all programmes.

Working remotely: Experience of working remotely from colleagues, based from home or in an office. Self motivated
