



Request a judge for a competition or challenge

Use STEM Ambassadors as judges for your events. They can judge remotely or attend in person competitions, providing you with an external official for your young people to impress.

Take a look at this example activity for ideas on what information you will need for your STEM Ambassador request:

About the Activity	
Activity Name	<i>This will be the first thing the STEM Ambassadors see so make it clear and concise. You can add your school name here to attract local Ambassadors. For example:</i> Judge London Academy's BIG STEM Challenge.
What do you want the STEM Ambassador to do?	Judging a STEM competition/challenge
Audience time and date	
About the audience	<i>You can choose multiple ages or audience types. For example:</i> 11 – 14 years students
Where will you activity take place?	<i>Will it be online, at your school / college or at an alternative site?</i>
Date and Total duration of the activity?	<i>How many hours will you need them to help you for?</i>
About the STEM Ambassadors you require	
How many STEM Ambassadors will you need?	<i>Depending on your activity, you may need more than 1. For example:</i> We would like 2 STEM Ambassadors
General area of expertise	<i>Will they need to have knowledge of a particular area of STEM? For example:</i> Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths
Specific areas of expertise	<i>Are there any areas it would be particularly good if the Ambassador had knowledge or experience of? For example:</i> Sustainability, mechanical engineering
What is the overall aim of the activity?	To develop team working skills, awareness of local environmental issues and give pupils the opportunity to present their ideas to somebody from outside of the school.
Short description of the activity	
<i>This is where you can describe the activity that you would like the STEM Ambassador(s) to do, it is worth noting where you can/can't be flexible. For example:</i> We are looking for 2 STEM Ambassadors to judge our BIG STEM challenge. The challenge takes place in a day at school with our 8 and 9 year old pupils. They will be asked to design and make a sustainable solution to a local problem. Each team will be presenting their ideas at the end of the day, we would like the STEM Ambassadors to attend the final part of the event which will be held from 3pm-5pm, listening to each presentation, judging the winner and handing out the prizes.
