



## Support a STEM Club

Request STEM Ambassadors to support your STEM Club sessions, events and competitions. STEM Ambassadors can deliver activities or acting as a judge or mentor for a particular STEM Club challenge.

Take a look at this example activity for ideas on what information you will need for your STEM Ambassador request:

About the Activity	
<b>Activity Name</b>	<i>This will be the first thing the STEM Ambassadors see so make it clear and concise. You can add your school name here to attract local Ambassadors. For example:</i> Hull High School's robotics club looking for some mentors.
<b>What do you want the STEM Ambassador to do?</b>	Supporting a STEM Club
Audience time and date	
<b>About the audience</b>	<i>You can choose multiple ages or audience types. For example:</i> 11 – 14 years
<b>Where will you activity take place?</b>	<i>Will it be online, at your school / college or at an alternative site?</i>
<b>Date and Total duration of the activity?</b>	<i>How many hours will you need them to help you for?</i>
About the STEM Ambassadors you require	
<b>How many STEM Ambassadors will you need?</b>	<i>Depending on your activity, you may need more than 1. For example:</i> 1 - 3
<b>General area of expertise</b>	<i>Will they need to have knowledge of a particular area of STEM? For example:</i> Technology
<b>Specific areas of expertise</b>	<i>Are there any areas it would be particularly good if the Ambassador had knowledge or experience of? For example:</i> Robotics and coding
<b>What is the overall aim of the activity?</b>	To support our girls to enter a national robotics competition.
Short description of the activity	
<i>This is where you can describe the activity that you would like the STEM Ambassador(s) to do, it is worth noting where you can/can't be flexible. For example:</i>	
<p>We are looking for volunteer mentors for our 3 robotics teams that are entering a robotics competition this year. The girls have split into 3 teams, so ideally we would like 3 mentors. The club happens from 3-4 every Wednesday but we are not expecting our mentors to attend every week. If you can spare 1 Wednesday each month for December, January and February, that would be amazing!</p> <p>The mentoring support is to help the girls solve a number of building and coding challenges. We would love them to have the chance to work with a mentor from industry who can give them some careers experiences as well as supporting them in the competition. The club has teachers on hand to help the girls with tricky coding bits, so you don't need to be an expert to help!</p>
