

Flying by Numbers – Information Sheet

The lift formula

$$L = d \times v^2 \times s \times C_L / 2$$

Where:

- L = lift (equal to the mass of the aircraft for level flight)
- d = density of the air
- v = velocity of the aircraft
- s = wing area of the aircraft
- C_L = coefficient of lift
