When 3 marked dots form the corners of an isosceles triangle, the game is over.

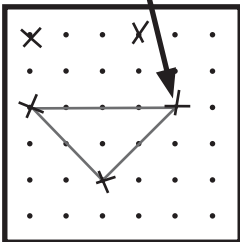
Draw in the triangle.

Whoever marked the last dot loses that game.

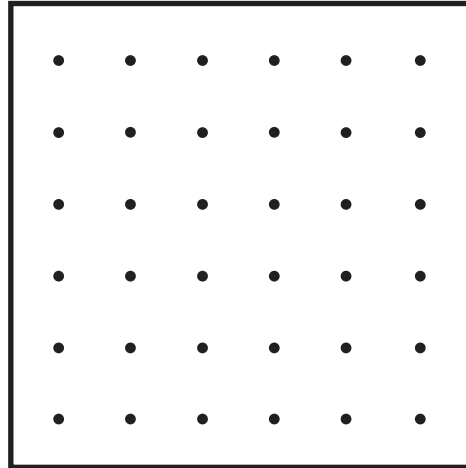
Now play another game.

## Sample game

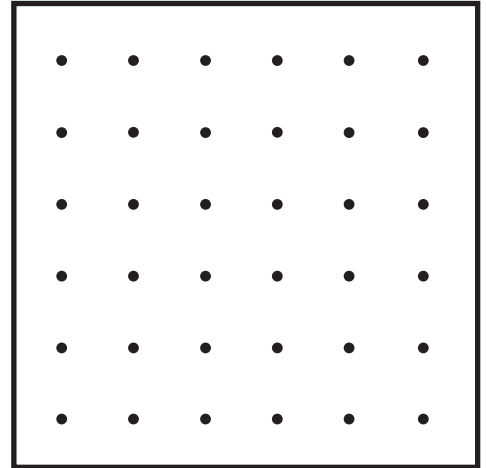
Ruby put a cross here and completed an isosceles triangle – so she lost.



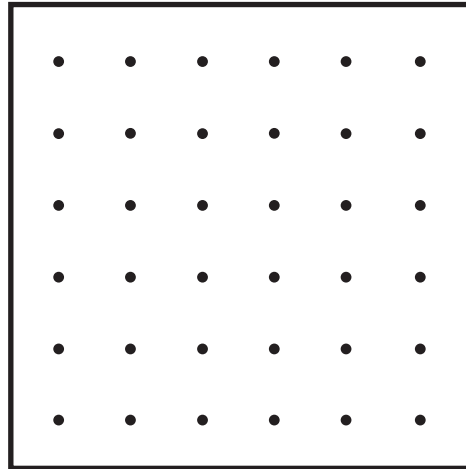
